Opener's Rebids After RHO Overcalls

General

Sometimes when RHO makes an overcall, sometimes this bid makes our life more difficult and sometimes it actually makes describing our hand easier.

- Vs. Lower-Level Overcalls
 - Space to make most of the rebids we had planned
 - Additional Calls
 - Pass
 - Support Double
- Vs. Higher Level Overcalls
 - Less space to describe our hand – some rebids are no longer available
 - Additional Calls
 - Pass
 - Support Double or Takeout Double

- 2NT Rebid
- 3NT Rebid
- 1-Suiter
 - Cheap Rebid
 - Jump Rebid
- 2-Suiter
 - Jump Shifts
 - Reverses
